- Boyd Midwest Family Private Foundation scholarships are determined by an independent review committee and are renewable for up to three years after the initial grant year (four years total).
- A minimum 2.5/4.0 grade point average in college, trade school, or graduate school is required to be eligible for renewal.
- Boyd Midwest Family Private Foundation may use my name and photo if selected for a scholarship, to publicly communicate about the scholarship award winners.
- An official high school transcript (2020-2024 graduates only) and, if applicable, a college transcript (for any applicant who has previously attended college), a photo (JPEG) must accompany your application.
